Guide to Atlanta

Getting around

MARTA (<http://www.itsmarta.com/>) is Atlanta's public transportation system. It is the best way to get around the city (it doesn't run from 1am to 5am). Single trips are \$2.50/ride + \$1.00 for the non-rechargeable ticket or \$2.00 for the rechargeable card. If you arrive at the airport during "normal" hours, there are usually many MARTA employees ready and willing to help you and answer your questions.

For International arrivals: Take the free shuttle bus to the domestic terminal to catch MARTA. Feel free to ask people for help finding the right shuttle to get to MARTA. People are very friendly and helpful and there are many airport employees who are paid to be friendly and helpful.

It's a direct ride from the airport to the North Avenue MARTA station. All trains from the airport go to North Avenue (and all southbound trains go to the airport). Trains run every 5 to 15 minutes, depending on time of day and day of week. It takes about 20 minutes from the airport to North Avenue. The station is in the basement of the AT&T Center. Exit to the north (follow signs to "AT&T Center"), unless going to Crowne Plaza. [Note: We aren't meeting at the AT&T Center – we're meeting across the street at the AT&T Midtown 2 building at 725 W Peachtree St., with main entrance on Cypress St.]

Taxi between the airport and Midtown (where we're meeting) is a flat \$32 + \$2 for each additional person. This is a published, negotiated rate, so don't let them rip you off. Some people tell me that walking from MARTA to a hotel at midnight is an uneasy experience (meeting homeless beggars on a deserted street at midnight), so please consider this when planning your local transportation.

If you insist on renting or driving a car, there are a variety of pay-to-park lots around. There's no free parking available.

Hotels and Meeting Location

Peachtree warning: *Peachtree St and W Peachtree St are NOT the same street. They run parallel, a block or two apart. Over 50 streets in Atlanta have "Peachtree" in their name. Make sure the street name matches precisely.*

AT&T warning: *We are not meeting in the big AT&T tower at 675 W Peachtree St, which is where everyone will direct you if you ask for directions to AT&T. We are at 725 W Peachtree St. See map below. The blue circles on the map are all AT&T buildings.*

There are 4 high-quality hotels nearby, within easy walking distance. Many other hotels are available that have easy MARTA access. If you will be commuting using MARTA, I suggest getting a hotel on the North-South MARTA line, and not north of Lindbergh station. At Peachtree Center Station (2 stations south of North Avenue) are the Hyatt Place Atlanta Downtown, Hilton Atlanta and Marriot Marquis Atlanta (for people wanting those hotel points).


3. THE GEORGIAN TERRACE [This is 2nd closest, next door to Hotel Indigo, and is popular because most rooms are large with Southern charm, and some have kitchenettes.
